PURE POLISHED secured a forward placing from the outset, stalked the pacesetter in hand racing to the bend, assumed command in upper stretch while not being asked for her best and steadily widened her margin in a ridden out effort. SWEET APTITUDE, reserved tracking the leaders along the inside in second flight racing to the turn, shifted off the inside to split foes after a half, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. WESTERN SWEEP was settled off the inside in the opening stages, angled inwards on the bend gaining momentum, split foes entering upper stretch, then drifted out in late stages while just lasting for a share. ROCKINWITHHER broke slowly, was settled along the inside, swung out four wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress. THAT'S A STORY tracked the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight racing to the turn but came up empty after a half. OIL MONEY'S DREAM was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, set the pace for a half and gave way.
