SHES DOWN WITH JIM, bumped at the start by SANTO RIO, shifted out brushing ENSORCEL, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead along the inside racing into the turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch and held safe the challenge of ENSORCEL to the end under energetic handling. The latter, brushed at the start, was urged to gain a position just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, prompted that foe to upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to close the gap while proving only second best. QUIET OUTLAW, caught four deep racing into the turn while under pressure to gain a contending position, tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight through the turn, shifted three wide in upper stretch while being urged to challenge but finished evenly in late stages while earning a share. SANTO RIO broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was shuffled back to last avoiding close quarters racing into the turn, continued near the inside on the turn, angled out five wide in upper stretch and made some progress to gain position. EYEMA DELIGHT, off last, was urged between foes to gain a contending position racing into the turn, shifted to the rail tracking the leaders in second flight racing to upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. SLIGO ROSE was prompted between foes, four, then three deep racing into the turn while dropping off the second flight, continued three deep to upper stretch but had no closing bid. SILVER DIRECTION was a brief factor three deep between foes chasing the leaders but steadily faded between foes racing into the stretch. ANYONESHOME tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from behind the second flight while saving ground throughout but lacked a rally.
