Footnotes

BINGORUN sped clear of his foes along the inside racing into the first turn, opened a commanding margin midway through the backstretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. REGGVILLE tracked the pacesetter unhurried inside foes in the second flight from out of striking distance for a half, made some progress to close the gap along the inside racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with the winner. AWESOMO hopped at the start, was settled in the last racing to the backstretch, steadily gained some position while angling five wide nearing the furlong marker and made some mild progress to the end while prevailing for a share. BOOGIE MAN JOE angled inwards racing into the first turn to track the pace between foes in second flight racing to the second bend, then continued evenly between foes to late stages. SAINT MUSKET, reserved off the pacesetter a bit off the inside leading the second flight into the backstretch, was urged along to close the gap racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. FAPTITUDE, reserved off the second flight while angling to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide midway through the backstretch, continued in that path to upper stretch but had no closing response. JOE MATT was settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch but never gained contention.
