MR PLAYWRIGHT raced inside, rallied in the stretch and did not miss by much. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE raced inside and got through on the rail to lead but was caught late. MANEKE contested the pace inside and tired. WISE JO JO raced close up off the rail and gave way. ORNERBY BY CHANCE vied for the lead off the rail and tired. (Race run in lane 1, rail out 6 feet.)
