Footnotes

SILKY SAMI was rated out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, steadily drew into contention shifting out five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command and go well clear late under firm encouragement. SORTA SASSY tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight, steadily moved to terms with the leader to press the issue into upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker but proved no match when confronted by the winner. RETAIL REGER tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the bend, was fanned four wide while being urged to challenge racing through the stretch but couldn't match the top pair late. S S DESSERT FIRST tracked off the second flight nearest the inside racing into the bend, switched out three wide racing through the stretch while being roused to challenge between foes but had no final bid. DA NELLA sped to the fore while angling to the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, gave way entering upper stretch while being steadied a bit avoiding close quarters. SHES GOT TO RUN tracked the pacesetter outside foes to the turn, continued three deep on the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. MILESTONEMISSILE settled last along the inside early and never gained contention.
