Footnotes

BURNT TREE, reserved between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, split foes just off the inside racing through the far turn advancing to contention and continued with a steady late gain to wrest command from CLASSIC RECITAL in time under firm encouragement. The latter raced within striking distance early stalking the pacesetter under firm rating inside foes in the second flight, advanced along the rail to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage leaving the furlong marker, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but came up second best. TAP THE DREAM angled inwards early to take up a position between foes in the second flight tracking the pacesetter under rating, moved to challenge the leader in tandem with several rivals nearing upper stretch while being fanned three deep and continued willingly to the end for a share while being outkicked by the top pair. CASTING, caught five wide nearing the first turn gaining a position in the second flight, was eased back from that position while shifting nearer to the inside racing into the backstretch, continued between foes moving to challenge racing through the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into the lane but continued with a steady effort to gain some position. CLAUDE MONET, shuffled back out of close quarters at the start, swerved out six wide racing into the first turn

while dropping briefly into last, made a steady four wide advance to contention racing into the far turn but flattened out entering upper stretch. NINE SIXTEEN moved to the fore while angling inwards racing into the first turn, dictated a comfortable pace into the second bend, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch and gave way between foes leaving the furlong marker. MY FEET HURT, reserved saving ground racing to the far turn, altered course nearing upper stretch avoiding TWO TRICK TONY and lacked a further response. POPEYES A SAILING, caught four deep between foes in the second flight racing into the first turn, continued with a steady three wide advance racing into the far turn but flattened out entering upper stretch. TWO TRICK TONY, pulling a bit between foes tracking just off the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail entering the backstretch continuing under some reserve, bobbed a bit, then was checked off the winner nearing the quarter mile marker and had no further response. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE INCIDENT NEAR THE QUARTER MILE MARKER BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
