ROTARY settled inside, slipped through mid stretch then angled out and was up late. GENERAL CHARLEY set the pace, led to deep stretch and was caught in the final strides. COSMIC KRIS moved to the leaders in the second turn but had no late kick. SIR RABBIT was very rank early, angled in and was gaining late stretch. GOLD SOUND (FR) was unruly in the gate, raced close up off the rail but failed to sustain the bid. ART OF DIPLOMACY had no speed and failed to menace. HANDSOME FEE chased the pace and flattened out.
