MALAWI broke readily, moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing along the rail into the turn, shook clear in upper stretch, then held sway on a clear margin to the end despite drifting out markedly in the last furlong while under firm hand urging and a few right handed taps. SAMARA STREET, held up off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, angled out four wide entering upper stretch while making steady progress and proved best of the others. ART OF SURVIVAL gained a position inside foes racing as part of the second flight and made the most of an inside trip, continuing evenly inside foes to prevail for a share. ARE YOU DANCING angled inwards while being urged to join a rival on the pace, prompted the pacesetter to upper stretch and gave way. PRIMA DONNA PIRATE tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but offered no closing bid. STONE FREE, urged along three deep leading the second flight racing into the turn, emptied out entering upper stretch. TATY'S GOLD shifted inwards after the start bumping COUGAR CRUISE, was collected off that foe, continued well off the second flight while angling out five wide racing into upper stretch and offered no rally. COUGAR CRUISE, a bit slow into stride, was bumped after the start, continued in last while being fanned six wide racing into the stretch and proved no menace.
