Footnotes

PRICELESS SHORE moved to the fore soon after the break while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, edged clear nearing upper stretch and held sway throughout while being kept to steady pressure. SANCERRE tracked just off the first flight with within striking distance in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but proved only second best. LIMESTONE settled off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid three deep between foes to prevail for a share in late stages. FUN ON THE BAYOU was settled in last in the opening half, shifted out making a four wide run racing through the turn while gaining some position nearing upper stretch and was just outfinished for third. WILD COMMAND, in close attendance to a rival's pace racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe after six furlongs and gave way nearing midstretch. CREATIVE WIZARD, held up off the first flight along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch but had no closing bid. RISING ICON tracked off the second flight outside a rival under light rating in the opening stages but never gained contention.
