Footnotes

KIPLING'S KING was rated along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting out five wide entering the lane, wrested command in that path late and edged clear under pressure. RADIANT DAY angled inwards a bit track to track the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, moved to challenge the leaders while being fanned four wide racing into upper stretch, continued with a steady effort to gain the advantage near the furlong marker but proved no match for the winner. DIVER was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, dueled for command inside a rival racing into the turn to upper stretch but weakened late. HE GONE reserved while racing in some close quarters, was urged to advance three deep between foes racing through the turn but lacked the needed final kick. RICHARD'S TUNE joined the pace three deep soon after the start, pressed the pace outside a rival racing into the turn to upper stretch and gave way. POWERFUL ZEN settled into stride along the rail, saved ground on the bend gradually gaining contention after a half but finished in hand late when lacking a path through the final three sixteenths. JAGUAR RIDGE, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, switched out approaching the turn and steadily faded from contention. JESUIT WARRIOR broke slowly, raced wide into the turn and proved no threat. AZEG was never a factor.
