COCONINO SLIM moved to the fore nearest the rail racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the second bend, was headed between calls racing into upper stretch but produced a steady late response to regain a clear advantage under firm handling. SOUND EFFECT tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued willingly to prevail for place honors while failing to gain terms with the winner. WHISKEY BRAVO, forwardly placed stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, pressed the issue on the far turn to strike the front nearing upper stretch but couldn't match the winner and lost second nearing the wire. THUNDER AFFAIR tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch and finished evenly inside foes late. KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, split foes while shifting out three deep advancing to contention in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BLUEDACIOUS tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the far turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
