Footnotes

MOSQUILLO took up a position tracking off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, made a steady advance in that path through the turn to challenge for command racing into upper stretch and went clear under firm encouragement. SPECIALIST tracked off the second flight between foes early, angled to the rail racing into the turn while making steady progress, shifted out in upper stretch and proved best of the others. OUTLINE broke awkwardly losing position to the field, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. SEEKING THE COACH angled to the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing into the turn, then continued evenly between foes on the turn to late stages. GAMBLIN JACK tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight early and continued evenly three deep between foes into the stretch. AUGUST DAY, held up between foes tracking off the second flight, lacked the needed late response. MISFIRED settled into stride near the inside early and never menaced. RUNNINGOUT OF CASH was hustled clear along the rail, set the pace racing into the turn and emptied out abruptly entering upper stretch. EXOTIC WILDCAT broke slowly and trailed throughout.
