Footnotes

DORSETT, reserved saving ground tracking well off the second flight in the opening stages, shifted out entering the backstretch, commenced a steady, three wide advance on the far turn to challenge for command racing past midstretch and drew away under firm handling. RIVER LEMON settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress four wide on the far turn, shifted out five wide entering the lane but continued with interest to prevail for place honors late. PROFESSOR PALMER was guided to the inside early tracking the leaders from out of striking distance as part of the second flight, steadily drew into contention along the inside racing into the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to gain some position three deep between foes but lacked the needed final bid. BREAKING BALL was rated stalking the pacesetter from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, moved to press the issue between foes racing into the far turn, continued to dispute the issue past the furlong marker but yielded late. NO APOLOGIZES, reserved near the inside racing into the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. MASTMAN sped clear of the field along the rail, dictated the pace under light rating to the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged racing through the far turn but emptied out late. PERFECTLY AT HOME tracked the leaders three deep in second flight racing to the backstretch but came up empty racing through the far turn. GREYTAP tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight but steadily faded after a half.
