### Footnotes

SANDIA CREST was settled in the last flight along the rail in the opening half, angled out on the turn steadily drawing into contention, shifted five wide entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time. SWEET LUCA, reserved outside a rival from out of striking distance in the opening half, circled into striking distance shifting five wide leaving the midway point of the turn, moved to gain brief command in that path racing into upper stretch, shifted in under pressure and just failed to contain the winner. REAL POWER broke inwards bumping FEELS LIKE FLYING, was reserved off the second flight off the inside in the opening stages, shifted to the rail entering the bend steadily drawing into striking distance, continued in hand between foes racing into upper stretch awaiting an opening, then switched outside rivals in the final stages to prevail for a share. REPORT CARD shied a bit at the start, was righted to gain a position inside foes in the second flight racing under light rating in the opening stages, advanced to brief contention along the rail nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain that effort in late stages. FEELS LIKE FLYING, bumped at the start, was held up off the leaders in the opening stages to race three deep in the second flight, steadily drew into contention on the bend to lodge a brief, four wide bid between foes nearing upper stretch but proved empty in the drive. TWELVE HUNDRED broke inwards, was righted, then urged to secure a forward placing along the inside, pressed inside the pacesetter on the turn to gain a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum. ITALIAN BREEZE sped clear outside foes in the opening stages, shifted in setting the pace racing into the turn but emptied out abruptly once headed nearing upper stretch. YANKEE DEALER was rated between foes in the second flight, moved to challenge in tandem with several rivals three deep between foes leaving the turn but quickly came up empty in upper stretch.
