Footnotes

IT'S TAMARENO broke inwards making some contact with SWEET HARP, was urged to gain a contending position just behind the first flight racing into the turn, steadily drew into striking position along the rail nearing upper stretch while briefly awaiting an opening, then came through inside foes in the closing stages to wrest command in time under steady handling. SHO BIZ SREVA was urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside in the opening stages, maintained a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, shifted out under pressure leaving the furlong marker and just failed to contain the winner's final bid. STORMING WILDCAT, a bit reluctant to load in the starting gate, broke readily to force the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, continued to press the issue into upper stretch but couldn't quite match terms with the top pair late. PROUD PICK, caught in close quarters at the start, shifted to the rail early, made steady progress inside foes racing into the turn to gain terms with the second flight midway through the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. SING IT OUT, held up off foes in close quarters near the inside in the opening stages, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance a bit off the inside racing into the turn, was fanned five wide in upper stretch and had no closing bid. REBA'S FANCY, bumped from both sides, then shuffled back at the start, settled into stride racing to the turn but never gained contention. SWEET HARP, bumped, then steadied a bit between foes in the opening stages, shifted out racing into the turn to track the leaders three deep in second flight, was fanned six wide in upper stretch and had no further response. KEEPINGTHEPROMISE settled outside foes in the opening stages and soon dropped out of contention.
