CUMULONIMBLE was prompted to gain a position outside a rival tracking just off the first flight racing into the first turn, dropped off the leaders to track those foes from out of striking distance for a half, made steady progress to regain contention while shifting out three deep racing into upper stretch, then wrested command and drew clear under firm handling. PATHWAY angled to the rail tracking just off the first flight in the opening stages, was allowed to drop well off the leaders racing through the backstretch, but continued with a steady effort while shifting four wide racing into upper stretch to gain even terms with a rival on the wire to share place honors. KATIE THE LADY was urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, couldn't fend off the winner's bid but continued willingly to the end to hold for place honors. PEYOTE PATTY went up to prompt the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the issue racing into the far turn and weakened nearing the furlong marker. KEPI was settled in the last flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, came around a tiring foe leaving the far turn and made some belated progress inside foes racing through the stretch. DUNDALK DUST tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, angled out five wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. MOURETTE tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn but offered no closing bid. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM was settled outside a rival in the last flight in the opening stages and soon trailed.
