SUAVITER raced close up inside, angled off the rail for the drive and rallied for the decision. TAKE D' TOUR set the pace from the inside then could not resist the winner but held on well for the place. ROSEAL lacked speed, angled out and rallied belatedly for a share. ACCEPTWITHPLEASURE lacked speed inside rallied on the turn and flattened out. THUNDERBDANCING raced close up inside and lacked a rally. EVERS MILE was never a serious factor. PRETTY AND WILD raced close up off the rail and weakened. SIMPLY PERFECT failed to reach a contending position. SULLY'S WISH was always outrun. FRENCH ACCOUNT was also outrun. SONOMA SUNSET raced near the middle of the field and gave way. TEA IS SERVED raced close up off the rail and gave way. (Race run in lane 1, rail out 6 feet.)
