PADDY WHACK lacked speed off the rail, moved up outside on the turn, took the lead in deep stretch and drew clear. FITTIPALDI raced off the rail near the middle of the field and responded for the place while not a threat. KISS OF DEATH raced close up three wide and took a short lead in the stretch but could not last. MORNING GOLD lacked speed off the rail and improved his position. REAL HOLY raced off the rail near the middle of the field and failed to rally. SAN SABA raced outside and made a bid on the turn but faltered in the drive. MR. QUACKENBUSH raced close up inside and gave way. FABLED JAZZ lacked speed and was not a factor. MILTON vied for the lead off the rail and tired. LIKELY WILL trailed throughout.
