### Footnotes

HOODLUM, rated in hand off the second flight in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance splitting foes midway through the far turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and produced a solid closing response to wrest command from KING ROOTIN TOOTIN in time under steady handling. The latter broke readily to gain the lead racing to the first bend, dictated the pace under light rating near the inside into the far turn, was roused clear in upper stretch and just failed to contain the winner. LIGHTHOUSE PRIDE, held up just off the first flight in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the backstretch to track in second flight, came through close quarters along the inside to challenge leaving midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. FUN ON THE BAYOU, held up out of tight quarters at the start, continued under reserve along the inside to the far turn, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and made some belated progress. E. BLUE settled off the second flight in the opening half, then split foes racing into upper stretch in an even effort. DEVILS TOWER tracked just off the pacesetter under some reserve in the opening half, pressed that foe racing through the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. YUKAN DO IT TOO tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, made a brief, three wide bid racing into the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. THERE GOES BEAU BO, held up outside foes off the second flight, was caught wide racing through the far turn and lacked the needed rally. ROYAL JAKE settled into stride along the inside and never mounted a serious challenge.
