**Footnotes**

OLD HICKORY was urged to secure the lead inside foes in the opening stages, turned back several challenges nearing upper stretch to gain a commanding advantage and held sway to the end under firm handling. TENSAW, held up out of close quarters just after the start, settled near the inside racing to the bend, switched outside foes to make steady progress on the turn, angled inwards to split foes nearing midstretch and continued with a steady response to prove clearly best of the others. CROFTER angled inwards while being urged to join the pace, prompted the pace between foes racing into the turn, couldn't match the winner and weakened nearing midstretch. JAMBONIED, urged along four, then three deep chasing the leaders, pressed the issue in that path racing through the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. ENERGETIC SREVA, bumped by BENNETT G at the start, tracked off the second flight unhurried in the opening stages, switched outside foes while making some progress on the turn to race four wide into upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. WILD COMMAND angled to the inside tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the turn and steadily faded in the drive. BENNETT G broke inwards bumping a rival, was steadied off that foe, settled into stride and never menaced thereafter. RAINBOW CLUB was settled between foes off the second flight and never mounted a serious challenge. SWINGIN WILDCAT, off a step slow, then pinched back at the start, never seriously menaced. UP DOVER HILL dropped out of contention early.
