Footnotes

CROSS EYED MARY tracked the leaders under light rating near the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out three wide nearing upper stretch while steadily advancing on those foes, took charge leaving the furlong marker and was driven clear. I SEE MAMBO, held up between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing the turn while steadily drawing into contention, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted outside a tiring foe leaving midstretch and prevailed for place honors. MISS CHLOE H. moved to gain a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe racing to the turn, was urged to challenge between foes nearing the quarter mile marker, shifted to the rail entering upper stretch while disputing the lead and weakened leaving the furlong marker. LOST ACCOUNT, reserved in last racing to the turn, shifted out splitting foes three deep racing into stretch while making an effort to improve position. LAMBORGENIE bobbled at the start, was righted to track the pace outside foes from out of striking distance early, made some brief progress while being fanned four wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded in the last quarter. EMMY moved to the fore along the inside, set the pace for a half and emptied out.
