Footnotes

UNBRIDLED VICAR angled inwards in the opening stages while being reserved between foes, steadily gathered momentum on the bend, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to prevail in time. SUMMER'S EMPIRE tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight, shifted out leaving the midway point of the turn to bid between foes nearing upper stretch, disputed the issue in a prolonged drive to late stages and just prevailed for second while shifting out a bit in the final strides. TSUNAMI KING reserved along the inside in the opening half, steadily gained contention entering the turn while shifting off the inside, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, continued with a steady bid in that path to late stages and was just outfinished while racing in some tight quarters late. TIMELESS FACTS, urged to the fore disputing the lead inside a rival in the opening stages, gained the advantage entering the bend to set the pace on a narrow margin, was roused when challenged nearing upper stretch and resisted grudgingly to the end while being just outfinished for a share. CALL SHOT tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight, moved briefly to contention while caught four wide racing through the turn and steadily faded. RIVER OF NO RETURN went up to force the pace outside a rival racing through the backstretch but was spent after a half. OUGHTA BE MINE settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention.
