Footnotes

IZZAEVEN broke slowly, settled into stride outside foes, commenced a steady advance while racing five wide into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch but made steady progress to wrest command and kick clear late under pressure. MISS PALATINE tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, split foes entering the bend moving to contention, bid four wide between foes nearing upper stretch, couldn't match the winner's kick but proved best of the others. AVANTIBDANCING moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing to the turn, briefly resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch but weakened in late stages. COUGAR CRUISE, a bit slow into stride, settled in last to the turn, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and made some belated progress. BLOND WARRIOR joined the pace outside a rival attending the tempo in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch but soon gave way. BERYOZKA tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight early, shifted out of close quarters entering the turn while making a brief bid turn but lacked the needed closing response. AIN'T NO SAINT angled to the inside

early tracking behind the second flight, was steadied off foes along the rail nearing the bend and had no rally. DREAM'N BACK, restless in the gate before the start, never gained contention. ZOOMIE ZOOMIE broke slowly, was settled along the inside early and never menaced thereafter. SHARP TRIP tracked the leaders inside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening stages but steadily faded from contention on the turn. COUNTRY CAUCUS tracked off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages but was through after a half.
