RUBY LIGHT set the pace and shook loose on the turn then continued gamely while challenged but missed. BLUSHING CALLER raced off the rail and lacked a winning bid. MALAGRA'S MISTRESS raced four wide and rallied to loom boldly in the stretch but flattened out late. INDIAN PAINTBRUSH lacked speed and showed little. LATE OF COURSE was always outrun. YELLOW TRAIN stalked the pace inside and gave way.
