Footnotes

METROSMILE took up a tracking position racing just out of striking distance along the rail in the opening stages, shifted outside a tiring foe nearing upper stretch, awaited an opening racing to the furlong marker, shifted back to the rail with a sharp move in late stages and responded to stout pressure to wrest command and go clear in time. A BRUSH OF BEAUTY, urged to a forward placing along the inside from the break, shifted outside the pacesetter entering the bend to bid between foes racing into upper stretch, held a narrow margin to late stages but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. CAMPO JOTI made steady progress outside foes to gain terms with the first flight after the opening quarter, pressed the issue three wide into upper stretch but was outfinished. STORMIN BON tracked the leaders three deep between foes in second flight racing to the turn, shifted out four deep to bid between foes in upper stretch but was outkicked. CHANTILLY CHARM tracked the leaders four wide in second flight in the opening stages, continued in that path on the bend while continuing with interest, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but finished willingly. WILDWOOD DURING came under pressure to contend soon after the break, angled to the inside nearing the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. LUCKIES ACT angled inwards to track the pace between foes in second flight but dropped out of contention early. EYES A JEWEL was hustled to the lead from between foes, angled inside once clear, disputed the pace inside foes on the bend but gave way after a half. VASILOPETA was slow into stride and never mounted a serious challenge.
