ANN OF THE DANCE, bumped soundly at the start, was urged along racing inside foes while losing some position nearing the turn, steadily gathered momentum along the rail nearing upper stretch, steadied out of tight quarters leaving the quarter mile marker, shifted out in upper stretch, then produced a solid late response racing five deep in late stages to prevail in time under firm handling. CIRCULAR STREET tracked off the second flight unhurried while angling to the inside early, shifted out four wide while steadily advancing racing through the stretch, was outkicked by the winner but prevailed for place honors on the wire. YORONA broke inwards bumping the eventual winner soundly, was righted to track the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight, continued with a steady bid into the stretch to wrest command between calls late but couldn't fend off the top pair. BLOND WARRIOR tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, made some progress racing into the stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. MY KENTUCKY ROSE tracked the pace outside foes in the last flight early, shifted inwards on the bend, was steadied a bit when caught in tight quarters between foes leaving the quarter mile marker and couldn't menace further. ONE HOT PHILLY sprinted clear of her rivals while angling to the inside, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the last furlong. BEYYA tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded from contention nearing upper stretch.
