BRAIN TEAZE was guided to the inside early tracking unhurried off the second flight, commenced a steady advance inside foes nearing the turn, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep, took over in late stages and held safe the challenge of OFFICER LEX under firm encouragement. The latter, a bit rank in the opening stages while being reserved in hand, saved ground on the turn while drawing into contention, steadied in close quarters near the quarter mile marker and again in upper stretch, split foes nearing the furlong marker to bid inside the winner but couldn't gain even terms with that foe. DRIFTING WIND settled outside foes in the opening stages, made steady progress racing five wide through the turn and continued willingly in that path to earn a share. FLYING ACT tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the bend, shifted out to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch, gained brief command nearing the furlong marker but couldn't fend off the top pair late. BOSS ALLEY settled well off the pace in the opening stages, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and continued to make some belated progress. CHARBOURG tracked off the second flight racing three deep into the bend but was through after a half. GIBBY'S TORNADO settled outside foes, angled to the inside racing into the turn but never seriously menaced. FLAMING HEAT forced the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, gained a clear advantage on the turn but gave way abruptly in upper stretch. AMAZING BUD was urged to dispute the pace along the rail racing into the turn and emptied out nearing upper stretch. UNEXPECTEDDIVIDEND tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend and was spent after a half.
