**Footnotes**

BIG LOOIE broke readily, attended a rival's pace racing well off the inside in the opening half, angled inwards entering the bend continuing under some reserve, then responded to brisk handling to wrest command in the final stages. LANSING BLUE, reserved five deep in the opening stages, angled inwards a bit making a steady, three wide advance to gain contention and continued with interest to the end to prove second best. ROYAL EXPRESS shifted off the inside a bit in the opening stages while moving to terms with a rival on the lead, dictated the pace racing into the turn, held sway past the furlong marker but faltered late. SEGURO, bumped by OFFICER MCNEAL at the start, was settled along the inside in the opening half, swung out five deep entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. ROARIN MISSILE, held up tracking the leaders from out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. OFFICER MCNEAL broke inwards, bumped SEGURO, was righted to track off the second flight outside a rival racing to the bend but offered no rally. DEVIENT BEHAVIOR, under reserve stalking just off the first flight along the inside racing into the bend, came up empty entering upper stretch. SLEWZOOM worked his way to the rail in early stages, saved ground to upper stretch but never mounted a serious challenge. RICH CITY DUDE was settled between foes early and never mounted a serious challenge.
