BUZZ MY BELL was guided nearer the inside while gaining position just off the first flight in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out to split foes nearing the three sixteenths marker, then made steady progress to wrest command and edge clear late under firm right handed encouragement. SISTER SISTER went readily to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace under some reserve racing to the bend, edged clear in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. MILESTONEMISSILE, off a step slowly, was reserved near the inside racing to the bend, lacked a path from which to challenge nearing upper stretch, swung five wide entering the lane and produced a solid late response to earn a share. SUNLACED tracked just off and outside the second flight under rating in early stages, angled four wide nearing upper stretch and continued with a mild bid between foes. ZIPPING AWAY broke inwards hitting the gate at the start, saved ground while under some pressure to advance, continued along the inside into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. IZZAEVEN was settled outside a rival in the opening stages, split foes near the inside entering upper stretch but had no final kick. VICKY'S BAR, steadied out of tight quarters just after the start, never menaced thereafter. O SO PRUDENT angled inwards to stalk just off the first flight in the opening stages, bid three wide nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. ANGEL COOKIE angled inwards from the break to force the pace outside a rival, pressed the issue through the turn and gave way in upper stretch.
