**Footnotes**

Gaelic Storm exchanged bumps with SWORD AND SHIELD at the start, was quickly righted to secure the lead along the inside, held sway into the far turn, then continued resolutely to turn back a challenge from STEPASIDE under strong handling to prevail. The latter, in close attendance to the pace between foes racing to the first turn, moved on the leader on the far turn to press that foe into upper stretch, couldn't match that foe but proved best of the others. DAVID K stumbled at the start, was settled along the inside, then made steady progress inside foes to the end to gain a share. MINING FOR SILVER was taken back off the first flight in early stages to track those foes along the inside, made a steady advance along the inside on the far turn to gain striking distance, shifted out three deep nearing midstretch but had no final response. NIC THE QUICK, reserved between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, was shuffled a bit in traffic entering the backstretch, continued under some reserve in close quarters nearing the far turn, shifted out entering upper stretch to split foes four wide making some contact with RAVENSWORTH, but continued with interest to improve his placing. SWORD AND SHIELD broke out, bumped GAELIC STORM, was reserved just off the inside between foes in midpack racing to the backstretch, was shuffled in traffic entering the second bend, continued along the inside and made some mild progress. LAST DEMAND tracked the leaders three wide in second flight to the far turn, was fanned four wide entering upper stretch and steadily faded. FRANK'S TIME was settled outside a rival in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but made no impact. RAVENSWORTH, forwardly placed three wide racing to the first turn, chased the pacesetter in that path

into the far turn, then was bumped by NIC THE QUICK in upper stretch while giving way. WOVOKA GHOST DANCE, caught four wide in the opening stages, angled inwards to track just off the first flight racing to the far turn, couldn't produce a closing response and emptied out in late stages.
