### Footnotes

FLATTERMEJIM gained a position inside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, made steady progress splitting foes racing through the turn to gain terms with the pacesetter nearing upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish with that foe past the furlong marker but narrowly prevailed under firm handling. TEASEBURGER, prominent between foes from the break, edged away to a clear advantage racing into the turn while angling to the inside, dueled for command along the rail through the stretch while resisting grudgingly and just failed to contain the winner. SAINT BREES tracked the leaders four wide deep in the second flight in the opening stages, advanced to striking position three deep in tandem with the winner racing through the turn but couldn't match terms with the top pair late. KEEP ME POSTED angled inwards soon after the break to track the leaders between foes in the second flight and continued evenly into the stretch. ECLIPTICALS T BIRD settled along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position inside foes. FAPTITUDE, held up off the second flight while three deep in the opening stages, was caught four wide racing through the turn while exchanging some contact with MISFIRED nearing upper stretch, continued in that path into upper stretch but had no closing bid. MISFIRED, off slowly, then held up out of tight quarters just after the start, raced in close quarters while being urged to contend racing three deep between foes on the turn but never gained striking distance. COOL PREN, urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, gave way entering the turn. CHEROKEECHALLENGER broke outwards, was righted to join the pace three deep in the opening furlong but gave way abruptly nearing the turn. AVOID was a brief factor racing five wide in the second flight in the opening quarter but retreated from contention early.
