### Footnotes

SANCERRE, reserved along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch to split foes while moving to striking distance, steadied a bit between foes entering upper stretch, switched inside the pacesetter approaching the furlong marker and continued with a steady late response to gain a clear advantage under pressure. JANUARY BEE broke readily, shifted to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing though the backstretch, was headed nearing upper stretch, resisted several challengers to regain the advantage in upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. MR NUM NUM, in touch between foes attending the pace in the opening stages, was urged to press the pace three deep between foes racing into upper stretch but weakened in late stages while continuing well enough to earn a share. PLUNDER tracked just off the first flight four deep in the opening half, advanced in that path on the bend to challenge for command nearing upper stretch but flattened out nearing the furlong marker. VIKING angled to the inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight, was urged to lodge a brief bid inside foes nearing upper stretch but quickly came up empty in the drive. STAR OF CLASS tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, was caught five wide racing through the turn and had no closing response. LOOKS TO SPARE, unruly in the gate prior to the start, broke slowly and never gained contention. EXCELLENT CHANCE, a bit restless in the gate, broke inwards bumping REIGNING CATFISH, was rated off the second flight racing to the turn and offered no rally. REIGNING CATFISH, bumped at the start, switched out to split foes three deep early while moving to terms with the pacesetter after the opening quarter, pressed the issue between foes racing into the turn to strike the front nearing upper stretch but quickly emptied out nearing midstretch.
