Footnotes

CALL ME CLASSY tracked off the second flight along the rail in the opening stages while getting some prompting to maintain contention racing through the backstretch, steadily advanced along the rail on the turn to challenge inside the first flight nearing upper stretch, wrested a clear advantage approaching the furlong marker and was kept to firm encouragement to maintain that margin to the end. BEACH CLUB angled inwards in the opening stages to track off the first flight between foes racing just out of striking distance, moved to challenge the pacesetter three deep nearing upper stretch, drifted out racing through the lane while disputing the issue outside the winner to the end but proved only second best. CHILEAN DREAMS tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the turn to bid between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while prevailing for a share. DIRECT BREEZE, off last, settled outside a rival in the opening half, angled to the rail racing through the turn and continued along the inside to the lane while making an effort to improve position. LADY JOBURG was urged to dispute the pace while shifting to the rail in the opening stages, gained the advantage after the opening quarter, set the pace into the bend while shifting a bit off the inside after six furlongs and emptied out abruptly once headed entering upper stretch. LITTLE WHITE STAR shifted out early to track the pace three deep behind the second flight in the opening half but faded from contention early. NEW GIRL was urged to the fore from the break, continued to prompt a rival's pace racing into the turn but was through after a half.
