SENATOR DAVE moved to the fore from the break disputing the pace while shifting to the inside, dueled for command into the turn, edged away to a clear advantage entering upper stretch and grudgingly held the challenge of IOLANDA'S PERFECT to the end under firm encouragement. The latter, bumped in the opening stages by SACRED RANGE, was righted to track off the leaders along the inside racing into the turn, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, drew on even terms with the winner late but was just outfinished. LAKOTA WOLF went up from the break to join the pace outside a rival, lost some position to the leaders entering the bend but continued tracking those foes four deep into upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages while earning a share. SACRED RANGE ducked outwards at the start, shifted in under correction bumping IOLANDA'S PERFECT, was righted while quickly moving to terms with the first flight between foes, pressed just outside the winner while between foes racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch when failing to match terms with that rival. VIKING tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and regained some position in an even effort. CAPTAIN AMERICAN settled into stride in the opening stages, was urged along to gain contention shifting out three deep racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing response. CHAMPAGNE TONY settled into stride while shifting nearer to the inside early and never gained contention. DEWISE shifted out in early stages while being prompted to lodge a brief, four wide bid after a half, then steadily retreated from contention racing through the turn.
