QUIETLY QUICK raced close up three wide, rallied to the lead in deep stretch and drew off late. SHANDY set the pace from the inside while pressed then could not hold off the winner. CAYENNE RED pressed the pace from off the rail but could not go with the winner and was outnodded for the place. CONNECTIONS was carried out on the turn but lacked a rally. ELITE lacked speed, steadied on the turn and improved his position. AMERICAN RACER steadied on the turn and weakened. SHAKESPEREAN STORY lacked speed and was not a factor. BIGBOYBDANCING stumbled on the turn and his rider lost the irons. (Race run in lane 3, rail out 6 feet.)
