**Footnotes**

BLAZING FINISH, reserved out of striking distance near the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn gradually gathering momentum, angled four wide nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance, then continued with a steady response to wrest command and draw clear late under firm encouragement. CURZON STREET, forwardly placed outside a rival attending that foe's pace, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch to gain the advantage between calls, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but proved only second best. CONTEMPORARY ART was rated along the inside tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance while part of the second flight in the opening half, switched out nearing upper stretch to bid between foes while racing in close quarters entering upper stretch, altered course in late stages avoiding close quarters near the rail but was outkicked by the top pair. LITTLE KINKAID, in touch with the leaders in the opening stages, was rated off the first flight to track those foes while shifting off the rail, continued with a steady effort to bid three deep between foes leaving the far turn but flattened out late. PROPER AMERICAN was urged to the fore outside a rival, shifted to the rail once gaining the advantage, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, briefly contested the issue nearing upper stretch but gave way entering the lane. HIPPODROME, outpaced early, never gained contention. WICENTY was rated off the second flight outside foes to the backstretch and steadily retreated after a half.
