Footnotes

SCORE BABY SCORE was rated just off the first flight between foes racing into the backstretch, shifted out three deep when presented an opening nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance and continued with a steady late response to wrest command from DOMINANT SUH and edge clear of that foe late under firm handling. The latter raced in close attendance to the pace between foes in the first flight in the opening half, pressed the issue on the far turn into upper stretch to gain the advantage, resisted the winner's bid past midstretch but proved only second best. CANDY TRAIN, in touch with the leaders three deep in the opening half, lost some position while being fanned four wide nearing upper stretch but continued with interest in that path to late stages to gain a share while exchanging some contact with RIVER OF NO RETURN in the final sixteenth. RIVER OF NO RETURN, taken back off the second flight while racing four deep in the opening stages, continued under reserve in last to the second bend, shifted to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch, then swung five wide in the closing stages to gain some position while exchanging some brushes with CANDY TRAIN late. FRANK'S TIME, reserved off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, continued three deep between foes racing into the stretch while making an even effort. LEMON CUSTARD, caught four wide racing into the first turn, continued outside rivals in the second flight, was fanned five wide nearing upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. STAR OF PARADISE, reserved along the inside behind the second flight in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, switched outside a tiring rival entering the lane but lacked the needed late response. RHODSEY moved to the fore along the rail racing to the first turn, disputed the lead inside foes racing into the second bend and gave way leaving midstretch. SAAR, caught five wide racing into the first turn, never gained contention.
