COME SEPTEMBER raced close up inside, came out three wide for the drive, rallied to the lead in the stretch and was not menaced while under a brisk hand ride. FACCIA BELLA saved ground near the middle of the field and rallied up the rail in the stretch for the place. DARLING L lacked speed and rallied belatedly through traffic for minor awards. LITTLE MO lacked speed, angled out and also had a belatedly bid that fell short. DENTONS RUBY pressed the pace just outside and weakened. JOHNNNA RAY set the pace from the inside while pressed and battled the winner but weakened late. WIN WON raced near the middle of the field and tired. SHEMYA raced off the rail near the middle of the field and tired.
