### Footnotes

HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE settled inside, angled out three wide, vied late in lane and all out to best foes. STICKSANJU was taken back after the start, moved up along the rail, vied late and was out nodded. DEPUTY CARTWRIGHT was never far back, got the lead mid stretch, and bested in the last strides. SOUL SINGER was unhurried early, angled out four wide then closed with a rush too late. EL INTOCHABLE pressed the pace, failed to sustain the bid and drifted out in the stretch. MARBLETON set the pace, led to mid stretch and faltered inside. SHARK KITTY broke inward and failed to menace. HIGHEST POINT was off very slowly and outrun.
