QUICK DELIVERY moved to the fore from between foes racing into the first turn, dictated the tempo along the inside on a comfortable pace to the far turn, then responded when roused clear racing into the stretch to prevail. BRUCE N AUTUMN, forwardly placed along the inside, was eased off the first flight nearing the turn to track those rivals along the inside under rating to the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch to challenge, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. PAISANO CREEK, reserved along the inside in the opening half, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes five wide while making some contact with FLY'N LION but continued with interest to prevail for a share. GRACIAS DERENZO tracked the pace between foes in hand racing just off the second flight to the far turn, angled to the rail leaving the midway point of the far turn and made an effort to improve position inside foes. CABERNEIGH, held up out of tight quarters a the start, switched outside foes to make a brief, four wide advance racing through the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. FLY'N LION, held up off the second flight while shifting off the inside early, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch while racing in tight quarters and jostled a bit between foes, then lacked the needed final response. GUADALCANAL settled in hand near the inside for a half, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. TUTTI BUONA GENTE gained terms with a rival on the pace racing into the first turn, couldn't match terms with that foe after six furlongs and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. HE'S BONAFIDE broke sharply, tracked just off the first flight

racing three deep into the backstretch, made a brief bid in that path approaching the far turn but came up empty after six furlongs.
