TALLY HO DIXIE was bothered at the start, angled out for the drive, rallied through the stretch and was along in time. MEGAWATTIE set the pace from the inside, took clear command in the stretch and just failed to last. PAUL'S DREAM lacked speed off the rail and rallied belatedly for a share. GRANNY'S PRIDE raced close up off the rail and weakened. GLITTERATION was not a factor. PARTY OF EIGHT raced close up three wide and gave way. Fractional times not available. Final time hand timed. (Race run in lane 3, rail out 6 feet.)
