Footnotes

AFFAIR DABBLER was reserved off the second flight outside foes in the opening half, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting out four wide nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide racing through the lane but produced a solid late response to wrest command in the final sixteenth while holding safe the challenge of TOP PAIR to the end under firm handling. The latter, reserved along the inside well off the second flight in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, then switched out sharply six wide racing through the last furlong while going well late to close the gap and prevail for second on the wire. CAVE CREEKER tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight in the opening half, moved to challenge for command in that path racing into upper stretch, struck the front between calls late and was just outkicked. BROKEN TRUST FUND settled between foes in the last flight racing to the far turn, shifted out to split foes four wide entering upper stretch, was roused to challenge between foes but was outkicked by the top trio. KEEP ON SINGING tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn while urged to advance between foes near the inside racing into upper stretch, was caught in close quarters nearing midstretch and lacked the needed final kick. JAZZ BEAT angled inwards to stalk just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch to strike the front nearing the furlong marker but failed to sustain her momentum. AMBIENT was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the far turn, was fanned five wide entering the lane but lacked the needed final response. J J'S CLASSIC tracked the leader inside foes in the second flight under rating into the second bend, shifted out nearing upper stretch while awaiting an opening, then was steadied while being shuffled back out of tight quarters approaching the furlong marker and dropped out. HAPPY HENRIETTA was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail into the second bend

but emptied out nearing midstretch.
