HA LONG BAY, never far back, was rated outside a rival tracking just off the first flight in the opening half, steadily advanced on the leaders to force the issue three deep nearing upper stretch and was roused away to a clear advantage in the closing stages. RAPE, reserved off the second flight in the opening stages, moved to gain a position between foes in second flight midway through the backstretch, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to advance, couldn't match the winner's kick but narrowly prevailed for place honors on the wire. ROI LE ROY settled into stride along the inside in the opening half, shifted out splitting foes nearing upper stretch while commencing his advance, shifted in sharply to the rail near the furlong marker to bid inside rivals and continued willingly to the end to close the gap while just missing for second. BLUE LASER gained terms with a rival on the pace from the break, ceded the lead to that foe entering the first turn to attend the pace under light rating to the second bend, was urged to press between foes racing into upper stretch but was outkicked in the closing stages. PRIME PROSPECTOR moved to the fore along the inside while under rating racing into the first turn, dictated the pace in hand on a narrow margin into the second bend, dueled for command while shifting off the inside racing into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. DOUG JUNIOR, rank under restraint while gaining a position inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued along the inside into the second bend and came up empty entering upper stretch. AFLEET PADDY settled off the second flight in the opening stages, was caught wide racing into the far turn and lacked a rally.
