Footnotes

CASHMERE MUFFIN was settled outside a rival racing well out of striking distance in the opening half, made steady progress outside foes on the far turn gradually gaining contention, angled four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a solid late response to prevail in time under firm handling. OUR BARRY GIRL sped clear of her rivals into the first turn to establish a commanding advantage, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin into the far turn, resisted when challenged nearing midstretch but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. SARAH'S SPLENDOR tracked the pacesetter inside a rival in the second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn while being prompted to advance, bid between foes nearing midstretch, then was forced to alter course three deep in the closing stages while continuing with interest to regain some position nearing the wire. PUSHIN UP DAISY was reserved along the inside as part of the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out after a half while being prompted to advance, loomed boldly three deep racing into upper stretch but flattened out between foes in late stages. SPIRIT OF A NATION, held up between foes tracking just off the second flight while steadied a bit nearing the backstretch, shifted to the rail to track the leaders to the far turn but offered no rally. MAGIC SILK, caught three deep racing into the first turn tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight, dropped out of contention early. DESTINY'S AHEAD broke slowly, switched out four wide racing to the backstretch while being prompted to gain position in the second flight but dropped out early.
