ROLLING SEA went up to press the pace from off the rail, rallied to take a clear lead in the stretch and held sway in the run to the wire. RICH FANTASY raced off the rail, near the middle of the field, rallied in the lane then could not reach the winner. UNREAL ROCKET raced close up three wide and made a move on the turn but lacked a winning bid. DYNA SLAM lacked speed off the rail and improved her position in the stretch. LAMPOON was void of speed and also improved her position. ORIGINAL SPIN raced four wide and made a bid to contention on the turn but faltered in the final furlong. GITA set a pressured pace from the inside and tired. PASSIONATE KIP raced off the rail near the middle of the field and weakened. ALBATA raced inside near the middle of the field and gave way. CAUSE SHE'S CRAFTY was always outrun. XCELLENT LISA raced close up off the rail but succumbed early. GRETA SUSANNA trailed throughout.
