Footnotes

KHUKURI moved to the fore while shifting sharply to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, forged clear entering upper stretch and drew away under steady encouragement. GENTLE MOMENT, reserved between foes racing just off the second flight, split rivals near the inside entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prove best of the others. REPENTER tracked just off the leaders under some reserve inside foes in the second flight racing to the bend, made some progress along the rail to lodge his bid nearing upper stretch, couldn't menace the winner and was outfinished for second. HELLO SAILOR tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside in the last flight early, swung outside foes leaving the midway point of the turn to race five wide into the stretch and displayed some mild interest while gaining some position. BILL OF BILLS, brushed at the start, was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. ROCKERFELLER broke outwards brushing BILL OF BILLS, was righted to track just off the leaders three deep racing into the turn, but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. COLLIDIN angled inwards sharply in the opening stages while moving to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the turn but gave way nearing upper stretch.
