WILD COMMAND moved to the fore soon after the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin while angling to the rail in the second quarter, held sway under firm encouragement racing into upper stretch, ducked out repeatedly in the last furlong while under stout pressure in a prolonged drive but maintained his advantage. C. C. BANJO, a step slow into stride, tracked the pacesetter unhurried a bit off the inside in the opening stages, worked his way to the rail entering the turn and continued with a steady response to make some mild progress along the inside racing through the stretch while prevailing for second. BE BRAVE, held up between foes tracking the leaders from out of striking distance, shifted out three wide nearing the bend commencing his advance, moved to challenge in that path in upper stretch, couldn't quite gain terms with the winner, was checked off that rival leaving the sixteenth marker when losing his path to that foe and crossed the wire in hand while gaining a share. EIGHT GAUGE, reserved outside foes in early stages, angled to the inside in the second quarter, lost some position to the second flight racing into the bend, switched out four wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression. ANY GIVEN TIME, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter while well off the inside in the opening half, angled inwards entering the bend to make a brief bid between foes after six furlongs but quickly proved empty in the last quarter. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF BE BRAVE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
