TRAC N JAM, settled into stride outside foes while dropping well out of striking distance in the opening half, continued outside foes on the second bend while being roused to advance, angled five wide nearing midstretch while finding her best stride and produced a steady late response to prevail under firm handling. HAPPY CHOICE, reserved between foes in the second flight in the opening half, switched out to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner. LONG LAKE KRISTA tracked the pacesetter from just out of striking distance inside a rival in the second flight, shifted out nearing the far turn to gain terms with the pacesetter, pressed the issue racing through the far turn to gain the lead nearing upper stretch, resisted the top pair to late stages but was outkicked. JULIET TANGO, held up off the second flight between foes in the opening half, was urged to advance splitting foes just off the inside racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. POORTOWN PRINCESS tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, lost some position to the leaders entering the far turn shifted out nearing upper stretch to make a brief, three wide bid between foes but proved empty in the last furlong. CRISPY, reserved in hand along the inside racing to the backstretch, continued inside foes to upper stretch but offered no rally. GINNY'S CLASSIC sped clear of the field into the first turn, drifted a bit nearing the six furlong marker, was righted to set the pace along the inside on the backstretch, dueled for command along the inside into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs.
