Footnotes

BURGAN RULES, reserved along the inside in the opening half, steadily shifted off the inside midway through the far turn gathering momentum, angled six wide racing into upper stretch while moving to challenge and narrowly prevailed in the closing stages under strong handling. IMAGE OF GRANDEUR, held up off the second flight in the opening stages, worked his way to the inside after the opening quarter, saved ground into the far turn, shifted out to split foes near the inside in upper stretch, bid inside the winner in late stages and just missed. FAN TAN MAN shifted off the inside early gaining a position in the second flight, moved to challenge leaving the far turn while shifting out five wide, gained the lead between calls late but was outkicked. PROUD NATION

shifted off the inside gaining a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge four wide between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. HENDERSON, reserved along the inside in the opening half, made an effort to improve his position inside foes racing into the stretch. GIRLS CHOICE brushed the gate, was held up three deep tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn but had no closing bid. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE, caught a bit wide racing into the first turn, tracked off and outside the second flight to the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. HOPE FOR TODAY, urged to secure a forward placing outside a rival in the opening stages, moved to press that foe racing into the far turn, disputed the issue into upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. FOREST RUN tracked the leaders in second flight outside a rival to the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. WILDWOOD ARAGORN tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn but emptied out entering upper stretch. PLAYON PLAYER was urged to the lead while angling over, was pulling against restraint entering the backstretch, disputed the lead inside a rival into the far turn and gave way. CATCH THE TRAIN reared at the start and trailed throughout.
