**Footnotes**

PROPHET'S SONG, bumped at the start, was hustled clear along the inside racing through the backstretch, held sway to upper stretch and was kept to brisk right handed pressure to maintain her advantage. HOLIDAY IN DIXIE settled out of striking distance while shifting nearer to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide entering the turn commencing a steady advance and continued in that path into upper stretch to close the gap while prevailing for second nearing the wire. CAMAGIN hopped at the start while breaking a bit slowly, angled to the rail on the backstretch, then continued willingly along the inside racing into the stretch to earn a share while being just outkicked for second. I GOT RHYTHM, unprepared for the start, was urged between foes to gain a position in the second flight, shifted in pursuing the winner racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. CAMP FAIRFAX R N tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight in the opening quarter, angled to the inside nearing upper stretch and gave way. JEANNIEDUBAI, urged along four deep racing off the second flight in the opening stages, never gained contention. INDIAN ICON soon dropped out of contention. PYROCLES broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, flashed brief pace while chasing the leader along the inside and soon gave way.
